



**A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark:**

*This is my Son, the beloved; listen to him.*

Jesus took with him Peter and James and John and led them up a high mountain where they could be alone by themselves. There in their presence he was transfigured: his clothes became dazzlingly white, whiter than any earthly bleacher could make them. Elijah appeared to them with Moses; and they were talking with Jesus. Then Peter spoke to Jesus. 'Rabbi,' he said 'it is wonderful for us to be here; so let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.' He did not know what to say; they were so frightened. And a cloud came, covering them in shadow; and there came a voice from the cloud, 'This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to him.' Then suddenly, when they looked round, they saw no one with them any more but only Jesus.

As they came down the mountain he warned them to tell no one what they had seen, until after the Son of Man had risen from the dead. They observed the warning faithfully, though among themselves they discussed what 'rising from the dead' could mean.

**Summary of Parish Council Meeting: 21 Feb. 2018**

**Documents Re: Pending:** These to be introduced to the New Parish Priest, Fr. Vincent Nguyen. Eg. Sister Parish of Hatolia; Tripping Hazard, Driveway at School Gate, Fencing at Meadow Heights, Cracks the butters of HF Centre, Finance Statements, and other important document files.

**Parking Signs for Meadow Heights:** The Sign Boards are ready to be install.

**Pavers at Dallas:** The long-time pending pavers have been laid in front of Church.

**Sister Parish, Hatolia:** Difficulty in getting the money across to them. Alternative to be considered.

**Holy Week Time-Table:** Suggestion to change the language at certain Mass-timings is to be taken up with the new Parish Priest.

**Croatian Catholic Community using our Church:** We are happy with the present arrangement but further discussions in March with them.

**New Projector for Dallas:** Money has been collected for this project but we are waiting for Fr Vincent to discuss this before proceeding.

**Heating and Cooling HFC:** The three reverse cycle air conditioners that serve the office areas at Holy Family Centre have been assessed and need replacement. Old and more expensive to fix.

**Holy Thursday Procession:** When the priest takes the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose, people may kneel and sing Tantum Ergo (Pangue Lingua).

**Use of Mary McKillop Hall:** It is affirmed that the people who hire the hall are not permitted to enter the area until 12:30pm on Sundays. We need to remind parishioners that they are able to hire this hall for wakes with prior permission from School.

**School Report:**

Bernadette Venables is the new Deputy and Religious Education Co-ordinator; School renovations making good progress; Possibility to establish a "Peace Garden"; High number of children at HCPS are RSL have special learning needs and so a special needs co-ordinator might be appointed.
