

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark:

This is my Son, the beloved; listen to him.

Jesus took with him Peter and James and John and led them up a high mountain where they could be alone by themselves. There in their presence he was transfigured: his clothes became dazzlingly white, whiter than any earthly bleacher could make them. Elijah appeared to them with Moses; and they were talking with Jesus. Then Peter spoke to Jesus. 'Rabbi,' he said 'it is wonderful for us to be here; so let us make three tents. one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.' He did not know what to say; they were so frightened. Summary of Parish Council Meeting: 21 Feb. 2018

Documents Re: Pending: These to be introduced to the New Parish Priest, Fr. Vincent Nguyen. Eg. Sister Parish of Hatolia; Tripping Hazard, Driveway at School Gate, Fencing at Meadow Heights, Cracks the butters of HF Centre, Finance Statements, and other important document files.

Parking Signs for Meadow Heights: The Sign Boards are ready to be install.

Pavers at Dallas: The long-time pending pavers have been laid in front of Church.

Sister Parish, Hatolia: Difficulty in getting the money across to them. Alternative to be considered.

School Report:

Bernadette Venables is the new Deputy and Religious Education Co-ordinator; School renovations making good progress; Possibility to establish a "Peace Garden"; High number of children at HCPS are RSL have special learning needs and so a special needs co-ordinator might be appointed.
