Third Sunday Year B Reflection

In today's Gospel Luke's primary interest is to show that the Risen Jesus is the same person the apostles had known prior to the crucifixion. He emphasises the reality of Jesus' bodily resurrection, but makes it clear that the resurrection is not a return to earthly life-Jesus has risen to a new life beyond death. Jesus ends the liturgy with a definite Dismissal Rite. "Get out of here and preach repentance and the forgivingness of God, beginning right here, right outside that door." As with any experience of intimacy, with God or with other humans, there will be implications. Intimacy invites us into mystery, into adventure, into deeper experiences of life. Jesus invites His intimate friends to go out and be intimate within all nations.
