

## **Fourth Sunday Year B Reflection**

Today's Gospel presents Jesus as the "good shepherd" and the One who cares for his sheep. God demonstrates His love for each of us. Jesus, is the true shepherd who knows the name of each of his sheep. It's a two way relationship. The sheep recognise the shepherd's voice and respond. We too, know the voice of Jesus when He calls us. This kind of love resembles the kind of love the Father has for Jesus. It is this kind of love that binds us to the Father, to Jesus and to each other.

The word "good" means "noble" and not just simply "good at" something. Jesus is willing to lay down his life for his sheep. This relationship is the basis for the sacrifice that Jesus makes on behalf of us, his sheep. Today, we reflect on those who have given dedicated service to the Church and its people.
