A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to John:
All who live in me, and I in them, bear much fruit.

Jesus said to his disciples:
'I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in me that bears no fruit he cuts away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes to make it bear even more. You are pruned already, by means of the word that I have spoken to you. Make your home in me, as I make mine in you. As a branch cannot bear fruit all by itself, but must remain part of the vine,

neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears fruit in plenty; for cut off from me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me is like a branch that has been thrown away - he withers; these branches are collected and thrown on the fire, and they are burnt. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask what you will and you shall get it. It is to the glory of my Father that you should bear much fruit, and then you will be my disciples.'

Fifth Sunday Year B Reflection

Using a metaphor (using a word/phrase in a way that is not literal) the vineyard. Jesus describes himself to his disciples as the true vine and his Father as the vinedresser. He further speaks of them as branches and explains to them that provided they remain part of the vine, they will bear much fruit. On the other hand, they will not bear fruit, if they cut off from the Father. In essence, to grow, to flourish, to bear fruit, the branches need to remain with the plant. A branch that is connected to the vine will continue to draw life and health from its roots. A branch that is cut off, on the other hand, will only wither and fade; it will never bear fruit. Jesus concludes that by bearing fruit, they will bring glory to the Father. Thus, they will truly be his disciples.
