

In May 2015, on the Feast of Pentecost Pope Francis unmasked his extraordinary encyclical on ecology and climate Laudato Si – Our common home – a blueprint for a change of hearts and minds.

Pope Francis wrote: "But we should be particularly indignant at the enormous inequalities in our midst, . . . We fail to see that some are mired in desperate and degrading poverty, with no way out, while others have not the faintest idea of what to do with their possessions, . . ." (no. 90). **As we celebrate Pentecost this coming Sunday, let us pray for the Holy Spirit's guidance on how to live a life that embodies the teaching of Jesus, " it is more blessed to give than to receive."**
