

**A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to Matthew:**

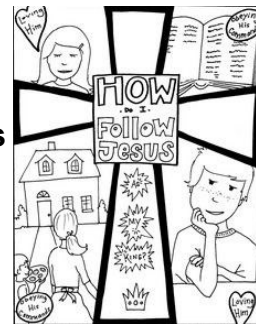
*The Lord God, ruler of all, merciful and loving.*

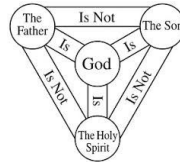

### The Holy Trinity Sunday Year B Reflection

On this Feast of the Holy Trinity, we pause to reflect on the great mystery of God. This feast is not meant to tie us in theological knots; it is concerned more with the wonder of God's mysterious and loving presence. We are being asked to be inspired by and to imitate the unity of the Trinity, the love of the persons of the Trinity, the harmony that exists within the Trinity. The Trinity is a seamless unity of persons, a community of love. The Father is the one who loves, the Son is the one who is loved and the Spirit is the very act of loving. Therefore, this reality, which we call mystery, teaches us three things: how to love, how to be loved and how to be love. As we sign ourselves with the cross today, a simple action, let us remember that we are signing ourselves in love and so let us live accordingly. We might not be able to help people understand the theological intricacies of this mystery, but we certainly can help them experience love.
