

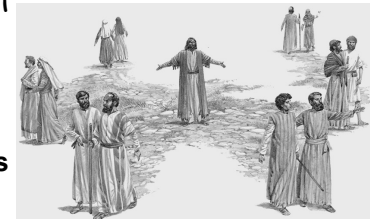
A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to Mark:

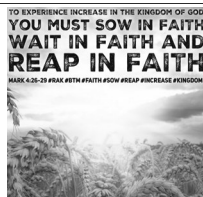

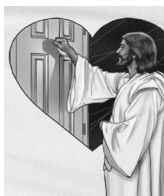
