## **EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORD. TIMES REFLECTION**

THE BREAD OF LIFE. The manna the Israelites discovered in the wilderness satisfied their hunger. More importantly, it was a sign that God was with them in their time of trial. It was a sign to them of the presence of God in Jesus. In the symbolic actions of the Eucharistic celebration, we also recognize the presence of Christ, the Bread of Life, among us. Jesus continues to invite us to recognize the treasures that God in His love is offering, which we often overlook or fail to appreciate. When we look at the situation of our own lives, or of our Church, and the world, perhaps our initial reaction is to do what the Israelites did: moan and grumble about our lot. The Lord's response is always to send us His blessings and His love, just as He showered down bread in answer to the Israelites' hunger. The challenge for us is to listen to the voice of those who, like Moses, call us to recognize the goodness of God, the freedom God brings us, the promised land to which God is leading us.
