

**A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to John:**

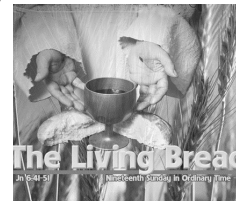
*I am the living bread come down from heaven.*

## 19TH SUNDAY IN ORD. TIMES REFLECTION

WHOEVER BELIEVES HAS ETERNAL LIFE. Throughout John's Gospel many people struggle to understand who Jesus was. Despite the signs He performed, they simply could not believe His claim that He has come from God. Certainly, this claim of Jesus is remarkable, even scandalous. We need the gift of faith to accept it. Our faith in Jesus, the Bread of Life, is expressed and deepened by our participation in the Eucharist. This everlasting life is part of who we are now. Believers even in the face of sorrow and persecution. Our faith in Jesus and in His resurrection finds expression in ordinary, everyday things. St Paul spells it out: "Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God". Do not hold grudges, do not lose your temper, do not raise your voice, do not call each other names, do not be spiteful. **INSTEAD** be friends, be kind, be forgiving, be loving. It is when life goes against us that we will see how great is the faith we have been given. Without God's grace we are nothing. In God's grace we may find the power to love one another.
