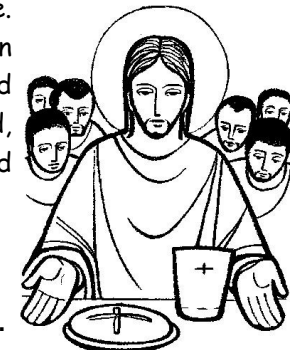

A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to John:

My flesh is real food and my blood is real drink.

Jesus said to the crowd: 'I am the living bread which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live for ever; and the bread that I shall give is my flesh, for the life of the world.' Then the Jews started arguing with one another: 'How can this man give us his flesh to eat?' they said. Jesus replied: 'I tell you most solemnly, if you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you will not have life in you. Anyone who does eat my flesh and drink my blood has eternal life, and I shall raise him up on the last day. For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood lives in me and I live in him. As I, who am sent by the living Father, myself draw life from the Father, so whoever eats me will draw life from me.

20TH SUNDAY IN ORD. TIMES REFLECTION

EAT MY FLESH, DRINK MY BLOOD. Jesus' proclamation that whoever eats His flesh and drinks His blood will have eternal life is like an advertisement for every Mass. It would be impossible to hear Jesus' words and not think of the Last Supper. Jesus took the bread, blessed, broke and gave it to His friends. Since then, the Eucharist has been the place for us to taste and see that the Lord is good. The Eucharist is God with us. It'd an encounter where our senses are deceived. The bread we eat is no mere bread, and the wine we drink is no mere wine - it has a deeper meaning. It is the real nourishment of Christ's body and blood, the source of everlasting life. The Eucharist is a reminder of Christ crucified and risen, the living bread where God is revealed as food and drink for life, as food and drink for love.
