Prepare for Employment - Free Training Opportunity

Are you thinking about looking for a job but not quite sure if you are ready yet or don't feel confident? You may need advice on developing some specific job skills or you may have existing skills and experience that you are not aware will help you gain employment.

The training sessions available will provide you with clear information about how work ready you are. You will learn about identifying your current skill levels and be provided with guidance and support about how you can develop your skills and learn new ones. All participants will be eligible for follow up support and advice and further 1 on 1 sessions with trained career advisors.

Each training session will be led by an experienced career advisor who will provide an introduction to the session and assist you in using a user friendly online program called the ERS tool. All equipment and materials will be provided for you.
