It is time for student to be wearing their winter uniforms.



Course will take place at <u>Holy Child Primary</u> <u>School Community Hub</u>.







- 3. Your CRN (Customer Reference Number) from the Family Assistance Office* If eligible, you may be entitled to receive the Australian Government Child Care Subsidy.

4. Payment method - To complete your registration, we require your preferred payment option. Don't be alarmed you will not be charged when registering.
