Our School

The Josephite Sisters established Holy Child Primary School, Dallas, in 1965 (Parish Reg). The Josephite ethos of pastoral care and community involvement are the hallmark of the Holy Child community.

Holy Child School is part of the Dallas parish, which serves the suburbs of Coolaroo, Meadow Heights, Dallas, Upfield, Campbellfield and parts of Broadmeadows.

Early in 2015, we celebrated 50 years, our silver jubilee, marking a significant milestone in our parish history.

St. Mary MacKillop, in full Saint Mary Helen MacKillop, also called Saint Mary of the Cross, (born 15 January 1842, Melbourne, Victoria, Australia - died 8 August 1909, North Sydney, New South Wales, Australia and canonized 17 October 2010. Feast day 8 August, religious figure, educator, and social reformer who was the first Australian beatified by the Roman Catholic Church and the first Australian to be recognised as one of its saints.

The staff and children of Holy Child School, Dallas are proud that their school was the first in Australia to start a children's Mary MacKillop group!

If you cannot come at this time, make a booking with before or after school care.

It is very important that we all work together to keep our school safe!

Your child can only come to school if they are well.

If your child

- is coughing
- has a sore throat
- is very tired
- has a runny nose has chills or sweats
- has a temperature above 37.5° •

They **CANNOT** come to school

If anyone in your house has tested positive for COVID-19

- Your child MUST STAY HOME
- You must call the school we can talk about how we can support you.

If your child is a close contact of another person with COVID-19

- They MUST STAY HOME
- You must call the school

If your child has to be isolated because of COVID-19, we will talk with you about the documents we need so that your child can safely return to school.

Uniform Policy

Rationale

Rationale

A uniform dress code reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Issues of equality, health and safety, and expense are also factors that contribute to the establishment of the Dress Code

Vision Statement¹

Aims

- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To further develop a sense of pride in, belonging to Holy Child Primary School.
- To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community.
- To be easily identifiable as members of Holy Child Primary School when out of school grounds.

Implementation

- Holy Child Primary School has developed a Uniform Policy that we believe provides choice for the students, allows for students to safely engage in the many varied school activities, and caters for the financial constraints of families.
- The Uniform Policy applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions, Casual Days accepted.
- All uniforms, including polo tops and hats, must be purchased from the School Uniform Shop.
- Summer and winter uniforms, as well as sports uniforms will be prescribed, and are required to be worn, at the appropriate time.
- Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, plus watches are the only acceptable jewellery.
- Decorative skin markings e.g. tattoos are not permitted.
- Extreme hair colors (e.g: green, pink or purple rinses) and/or extreme hairstyles (e.g: spikes or mohawks) are not permitted.
- Other than clear nail polish, cosmetics may not be worn at school.
- The only headgear that is acceptable, is school hats consistent with our Sunsmart policy. They must be worn outside from September to the end of April.
- If students wear hats which are not the school hat, they will be asked to remove that hat and sit in the shade. Hats are not to be worn inside.
- Students are **NOT** allowed to wear different coloured tights, leggings, socks, skivvies, jumpers, jackets, etc.

¹ As the community of Holy Child we are people of God empowered by the Holy Child (Jesus) to never see a need without doing something about it.

We empower each other to achieve our best and to develop as thoughtful, happy, optimistic, faith-filled people who contribute responsibly as active citizens.

- Black school shoes are to be worn every day except in your child's class P.E. (Sports Day).
- Sandals or thongs are **NEVER** to be worn to school, even on Casual days.
- Socks are to be worn at all times.
- Only gold or blue hair ribbons and hair ties are to be worn.
- Any hair, longer than shoulder length, must be tied back. (Girls and Boys)
- The Principal and all staff will be responsible for the implementation of the Uniform Policy.
- A written note must be provided when students will be out of uniform.
- A list of summer/winter and sport uniforms is attached, Appendix 1.
- Parents will be notified of students not in the correct uniform and ask them to bring the school uniform to school.

Evaluation

This Policy will be part of a four review cycle and be evaluated in 2024.

الاهداف

- الحفاظ على الصورة المتميزة والإيجابية للمدرسة في المجتمع.
- يكون من السهل التعرف على طلاب مدرستنا عند تواجدهم خارج المدرسة.

Interi

- لقد طورت المدرسة تدابير الزي الموحد حيث نعتقد بانها توفر للطلاب الاختيار، حيث تسمح للطلاب بالتفاعل والمشاركة في مختلف الأنشطة المدرسية، وتكاليفها مناسبة لجميع الأسر.
- يطبق الالتزام بالزي الموحد للمدرسة خلال ساعات الدوام الرسمى للمدرسة، وخلال التنقل من والى المدرسة، عند ذهاب الطلاب في رحلات مدرسية ، ما عدا الأيام التي يسمح لهم بارتداء الملابس العادية Casual Days.
- يجب شراء الزي الموحد الكامل من المدرسة ومن ضمنها تيشيرت المدرسة الاصفر الطويل و القصير الأكمام والقبعات المدرسية.
- سوف يتم تحديد زي المدرسة الصيفي والشتوي وكذلك زي الرياضي المطلوب ارتداءه في الوقت المناسب والمخصص.
 - المجو هرات المسموحة بارتدائها هي الحلق الصغير والساعة اليدوية فقط.
 - لا يسمح بأي رسم او وشم على الجسم.
- لايسمح بصبغ الشعر بالألوان الصارخة مثل (الأخضر والوردي والأرجواني) والتسريحات الشعر سبايكس (spikes, موهوكس).
 - لا يسمح بوضع المكياج وطلاء الأظافر ماعدا الشفاف.
- يسمح فقط بارتداء القبعات المدرسية المتوافقة مع سياسة SunSmart الخاصة بنا. يجب ارتداءها ابتداءا من شهر أيلول إلى نهاية شهر نيسان.

- إذا ارتدى الطلاب قبعات ليست القبعة المدرسية، فسوف يطلب منهم خلعها والجلوس في الظل. لا يسمح بارتداء القبعات داخل الصف.
 - لا يسمح للطلاب بارتداء ألوان مختلفة من (الجواريب الطويلة " الكولون"، السراويل الضيقة، جواريب، البلوزات ذات الرقبة ، الكنزات والسترات ... الخ).
 - يجب ارتداء الحذاء الأسود كل يوم ماعدا في الأيام المخصصة للتربية الرياضية.
 - لا يسمح بارتداء الاحذية الصيفية المكشوفة والنعل اطلاقا حتى في ايام التي يسمح بها بارتداء ملابس عادية.
 - يجب ارتداء الجواريب في جميع الأوقات.
 - يسمح بارتداء ربطات الشعر والاشرطة بالوان الزرقاء والذهبية فقط.
 - يجب ربط الشعر الأطول من مستوى الكتف (للبنات ، والأولاد).
 - سيكون المدير وجميع المعلمين مسؤولين عن تنفيذ الاجراءات الخاصة بالزي الموحد.
 - يجب تزويد المدرسة برسالة مكتوبة عن سبب عدم ارتداء الطلاب للزي المدرسة.
 - يرفق مع هذه الرسالة قائمة خاصة بزي المدرسة الصيفي/ الشتوي والرياضي.
- سيتم ابلاغ اولياء الامور في حالة عدم ارتداء أطفالهم الزي الصحيح وسوف يطلب منهم بإحضار زي المدرسي الى المدرسة.
