



I also wanted to write about the choice of games for our children to play on computer, Xbox and PS 4,5 etc. Games are rated because of the children's brain development. Games over PG can give our children experiences of trauma. Games that have extreme violence, very offensive language or have sexual content are rated as R 18 years plus these game are not good for our students as they give very bad messages about how to behave and it is also against the law. The next rating is MA 15+ these games have a strong impact on younger children and only legal for people over 15 years, the content of these games have unacceptable levels of violence and sexual themes which are bad for our children's development and understanding.

The next M is less offensive but still not for children less than 15 years these games still have high levels of violence and sexual themes though aren't as graphic as the higher games. PG games are where the content would have a mild impact on children's development, thinking and behaviour, these games need parent to check if they are comfortable before children using them. Lastly the G games are for children to use in a less supervised way as the content is appropriate for children in primary school. Parents please remember we are working in partnership with each-other and need your support, because our children are using the content of these games and language in school to talk to their friends and teachers.



#### **General Reminders**

#### SUN SMART

Australia has one of the highest rates of skin cancer in the world.

In Victoria, from September through to the end of April, average UV levels are 3 and above, which is when UV radiation can damage skin and eyes and lead to skin cancer. When the UV Index is 3 and above:



- 1. Slip on sun-protective clothing
- 2. Slop on SPF30+, broad spectrum, water resistant sunscreen - put it on 20 minutes before you go outdoors and every two hours afterwards
- 3. Slap on a hat - that protects your face, head, neck and ears
- 4. **Seek** shade
- Slide on some sunglasses make sure they meet Australian Standards. 5.



Children must wear the school hat during the break times at school.

During warmer weather, DRINK MORE WATER

As the weather warms up it is important that our children drink regularly. Children will need a clearly named and refillable drink bottle.

Please do not send food that needs re-heating. Due to health and safety, we are unable to heat children's food at school.

If paying by instalments (weekly, fortnightly or monthly), please ensure that all payments are made regularly, to avoid large amounts owing in Term 4.

Payments can be made by direct debit, by the school on your behalf, or you can do thru your bank, or you can come into the office and pay cash or pay by credit card.

#### **DIRECT DEBIT INCENTIVES**

All fee payers who pay by **CONTINUOUS** direct debit (including holidays) will receive the above discounts, if each term's fees are finalised by that term's due date.

As a bonus for Direct Debit payers, there is an extra \$50 discount given at the beginning of the following year if direct debits payments were **Continuous** from the start of the previous school year.
