

Important Reminders

From 11:59pm tonight, masks are no longer required to be worn outside as long as you are able to keep a distance of 1.5m from others. This means that from tomorrow (Friday 18 June) when you drop off or pick up your child at the school gate you do not need to be wearing a mask but **must keep your distance from others.** If you come into the school office, masks still need to be worn. If you are visiting Holy Child for more than 15 mins you must **sign the COVID-19 register**. Thank you for your support.

Term 2 concludes for our children at 1:40pm on Thursday 24 June. Friday is a professional day for our staff. Term 3 begins on Monday July 12 and the school gates will be open from 8:30am.

Our prep numbers for 2022 continue to increase. If you have a child who turns 5 by 30 April 2022 please collect an enrolment form from the school office and book an interview time. It is very important to enrol your child early so that they don't miss out on a place in prep next year.

Education in Faith

We are still collecting donations for the St Vincent de Paul Winter Appeal. If you are able, please send in a non-perishable food item (eg pasta or canned foods). I will take them to St Vincent de Paul next week. We do understand that this is a particularly challenging time and that some families are unable to donate.



Next term our school and parish will celebrate the Sacrament of First Eucharist. However, I can announce that we intend for the celebration to take place on Sunday 29 August at 2:00pm. Our Family Evening for this sacrament is still scheduled for Wednesday 11 August at 6:30pm.

Children playing outside the school grounds, before and after school, are not supervised until 8.30am before school and up to 3.40pm after school. SUN SMART

Australia has one of the highest rates of skin cancer in the world.

In Victoria, from September through to the end of April, average UV levels are 3 and above, which is when UV radiation can damage skin and eyes and lead to skin cancer. When the UV Index is 3 and above:



- 1. Slip on sun-protective clothing
- 2. **Slop** on SPF30+, broad spectrum, water resistant sunscreen - put it on 20 minutes before you go outdoors and every two hours afterwards
- 3. Slap on a hat - that protects your face, head, neck and ears
- 4. Seek shade
- Slide on some sunglasses make sure they meet Australian Standards. 5.



Children must wear the school hat during the break times at school.

During warmer weather, DRINK MORE WATER

As the weather warms up it is important that our children drink regularly. Children will need a clearly named and refillable drink bottle.

Please do not send food that needs re-heating. Due to health and safety, we are unable to heat children's food at school.
