A MESSAGE FROM THE DEPUTY PRINCIPAL

Living the Gospel

This week I have had the opportunity to continue planning Religious Education units and lessons with our teaching staff. It is vital that staff in Catholic schools have an opportunity to explore their own faith and can 'dialogue' this faith with their colleagues before leading Religious Education lessons with their students. Most importantly for our staff, our students and our parents it is in being called to 'action' our faith through living the 'Gospel' (God News).

One team unpacked the 'Parable of The Rich Man' (Luke 12: 16 - 21).

16 Then he told them a parable: "There was a wealthy man whose land yielded an abundant harvest. 17 He thought to himself, 'What shall I do, for I do not have sufficient space to store my crops?' 18 Then he said, 'This is what I will do. I will pull down my barns and build larger ones, where I will store my grain and other produce, 19 and I shall say to myself, "Now you have an abundance of goods stored up for many years to come. Relax, eat, drink, and be merry." '20 "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be required of you. And who then will get to enjoy the fruit of your labours?' 21 That is how it will be for the one who stores up treasure for himself yet fails to become rich in the sight of God."

We often hear that to fully live out the kingdom message of Jesus is to be counter-cultural. This parable is a perfect example of that call. Jesus himself acted in contrast to his cultural context and often used examples in his teaching that flew in the face of cultural expectation. What does it mean to be counter-cultural today? Our world is driven by an emphasis on the individual; an emphasis on acquisition; an emphasis on consuming. The kingdom parables call us to be the agents of change, that, in our own small way to make a difference in the world.

God bless you all. May we continue working together to provide the best Catholic education we can for our students.

MEDICAL ACTION PLANS

For the safety of our children



Dear Parents/Guardians/Carers,

As part of Holy Child Primary School's commitment to our children, please provide us with a **Medical Action Plan**, if required by your child; samples attached.

If your child has developed symptoms or their current medication has changed, take this letter to your medical practitioner to complete an appropriate Medical Action Plan, as per the attached samples.

Once completed, return the Medical Action Plan to the school as soon as possible, together with the student's medication and any other aid.

If your medical practitioner has informed you that your child no longer experiences any symptoms, he/she will need to provide a letter, on the practice letterhead, to the school stating such.

Dear Parents/Guardians/Carers,

A new enterprise agreement covering teachers across most of the Catholic schools in Victoria, including ours, has been approved and is in effect.

The new agreement delivers several positive changes for both our dedicated staff and the overall functioning of our school, including improved pay and employment conditions. One key aspect of this agreement is the inclusion of new time-in-lieu provisions, which will enable our teachers and support staff to accumulate additional time off when they are required to work more than their regular 38 hours per week which might include overnight camps and supervision at evening and weekend activities.

This change is a recognition of the considerable extra work our teachers are asked to do and will enhance their work-life balance and well-being.

However, implementing these changes will mean that students will finish up a couple of days earlier than usual, on Friday 15 December. This will limit any disruption to students throughout the year and enable our staff to avail themselves of their earned time off during the holiday season, rejuvenating themselves for the upcoming year.

I am letting you know now as I wanted to give you ample time of the new finishing up date to accommodate any changes to your schedules or arrangements at what is a busy time of the year.

We sincerely appreciate your understanding and support in this matter. By prioritising the wellbeing and work-life balance of our dedicated staff, we are fostering an environment that promotes excellence in teaching and learning.



Children playing outside the school grounds, before and after school, are not supervised until 8.30am before school and up to 3.40pm after school. Many children are going to the Jack Culpin Car Park\Reserve and Gibbs Reserve, before and after school, to wait for their parents' drop-off and pick-up. We are not able to supervise your children in these areas.

Please ensure that your children are collected from the School Grounds in Area 1. If your child is not collected by 3.40pm they are to be collected from the Reception Foyer.

SUNSMART

Australia has one of the highest rates of skin cancer in the world.

In Victoria, from September through to the end of April, average UV levels are 3 and above, which is when UV radiation can damage skin and eyes and lead to skin cancer. When the UV Index is 3 and above:

- 1. Slip on sun-protective clothing
- 2. **Slop on** SPF30+, broad spectrum, water resistant sunscreen put it on 20 minutes before you go outdoors and every two hours afterwards
- 3. **Slap** on a hat that protects your face, head, neck and ears
 - 4. Seek shade
 - 5. **Slide** on some sunglasses make sure they meet Australian Standards.

Holy Child is a SunSmart School and we enforce **NO HAT NO PLAY**.

Children must wear the school hat during the break times at school.

FOOD AND DRINK

During warmer weather, DRINK MORE WATER

As the weather warms up it is important that our children drink regularly.

Children will need a clearly named and refillable drink bottle.

Please do not send food that needs reheating.

Due to health and safety, we are unable to heat children's food at school.

During cooler weather

As the weather cools, ensure children are appropriately dressed for cold rainy days and if they are wearing a beanie or gloves that they are navy blue or black.

Beanies are available for purchase at the School.



IMPORTANT DRIVEWAY REMINDERS

DO NOT park your car in front of this gate and shed. This impacts any cars trying to turn out or back out of the car park.





THIS is the only gate to exit from (turn your vehicle left out of). Remembering our driveway is a one way 'drive through' driveway

THREE important reminders

- In the morning and the afternoon drivers are to move as far down the driveway as they can. You must be aware of other vehicles driving behind you.
- Children must get into and out of the car on the **passenger side** of the car (**NOT** the door behind the driver!) as this will stop students from walking between two cars.
- School bags must be inside the car with students and not in the boot of the car.




