June 29 is the combined celebration of Saints Peter and Paul, both apostles and martyrs. It is a solemnity, the highest rank for a liturgical feast. The two spent very limited time with each other. Paul was not with Peter and the Eleven during Jesus' three-year public ministry or for the initial years of the Christian community. Paul did spend fifteen momentous days with Peter in Jerusalem in 37 AD shortly after his conversion. The majority was private time, just the two of them alone. Peter shared his first-hand knowledge of Jesus, and Paul listened intently. They shared their faith, exchanged stories about their ministry, spoke of the privilege and challenge of preaching the gospel, and strategized about how to carry on. They would see each other again fourteen years later during the Council of Jerusalem in 51 AD. Peter and Paul would go their separate ways, Peter mainly to the Jews of Israel, Paul mainly to the Gentiles of Syria, Turkey, and Greece, both in the power of the Holy Spirit, outstanding witnesses to Jesus, preaching with incredible courage and conviction. They worked great miracles and made numerous converts. Both made major contributions to Scripture. Peter probably was the eyewitness source for Mark and his gospel, and he wrote two Pastoral Epistles himself, 1 and 2 Peter; while Paul is the most prolific writer of the New Testament with thirteen letters attributed to him.

PRESENTATION – “TALKING ABOUT GRIEF AND LOSS”

Join us for a presentation on “Talking about Grief and Loss” on **Sunday, July 20, at 3 PM, at the Holy Family Centre in Meadow Heights.** The speaker will be Rose Clark, a Spiritual and Pastoral Care Practitioner from the Royal Melbourne Hospital. There will be an opportunity to share personal grief journeys, and the presentation will conclude with afternoon tea.

Pilgrimage – Saturday 10th May 2025

On Saturday May 10th 2025 Fr Joe celebrated early morning mass for 15 of us, Holy child Pilgrims, then we gathered at Coolaroo station to ‘train it’ into the city. We all walked to St Patrick’s Cathedral where, outside, Fr Joe gave a little introductory talk, after which we had one and a half hours to explore and learn about the life of the early Melbourne Catholic Church. Inside, there was a very interesting display of the life of St Therese (her parents were also both canonised – the first married couple to be made saints), as well as beautiful stained-glass windows and lots of information about previous Archbishops. We next walked to the Mary MacKillop Heritage Centre where Sr Rita, using items from ‘the olden days’ told us of the life and struggles of Mary MacKillop and the early Josephite sisters. The museum there was very interesting too. We decided to have our lunch there as the park looked a bit ‘damp’. It was so enjoyable to sit, chat and eat with fellow parishioners – some of whom we don’t see every day. When we had cleaned up, we made our way back to the station and home again. A very big THANK YOU! To Fr Joe and Sr Veronica for organising and preparing info for us. We – the Holy Child Pilgrims all agreed that the whole day was a wonderful experience -something to remember forever, and a great way to celebrate the Church’s Year of Jubilee.
