

A SUMMARY OF PPC MEETING

Divine Renovation:

• Fr. Joe to invite the Divine Renovation Team to give a presentation to the Leadership Team in 2026.

PPC Report for the Parish Leadership Team Meeting - 31 July

Fr. Joe will ask Damian to prepare a brief report on the PPC's work for the Leadership Team Meeting on 31 August.

Feedback on the Launch of the Parish Vision and Mission Statement

- The Pastoral Council Members expressed disappointment regarding the low attendance of parishioners at the Launch of the Vision and Mission Statement.
- However, the Council was satisfied with the level of engagement from the small group of parishioners who participated in the discussion.
- There was a consensus that there were no significant objections from parishioners concerning the proposed Parish Vision and Mission Statement.
- The Council discussed and reflected on possible reasons for the lack of interest from parishioners in the Launch event.
- A suggestion was made for Fr. Joe, the parish priest, to be more visibly present to demonstrate his support for the discussion.

Adjustment of the Parish Vision and Mission Statement

- The PPC accepted a parishioner's suggestion to include recognition of the diverse cultures represented in the parish within the Vision and Mission Statement.
- The PPC made the following adjustment to the Vision Statement: "Unified in our diverse cultural heritage".
- The PPC approved the current version to act as a preliminary Vision and Mission Statement, which will be presented alongside the Pastoral Plan to parishioners in 2026.
- A proposal to establish a strategic plan to help parishioners move from the Mission and Vision Statement to the development of the Parish Pastoral Plan in 2026.
