REMINDERS

SunSmart: from September to April, when UV levels reach 3+, students must follow SunSmart guidelines; slip on protective clothing, slop on SPF30+ sunscreen, slap on a hat, seek shade, and slide on sunglasses; Holy Child enforces NO HAT NO PLAY.

Parent Parking: the front car park is for drop-off and pick-up only (max 10 minutes); do not use the disabled bay or block the gate, which must remain clear for emergency access.

No Smoking: our school is a strict smoke-free zone, and smoking is not allowed anywhere on or near school grounds.

Cool Weather: As the weather cools, ensure children are appropriately dressed for cold rainy days and if they are wearing a beanie or gloves that they are navy blue or black. Beanies are available for purchase at the school.

Guide To Medicare Bulk Billing

Medicare CDBS provides children aged 2-17 funding of \$1158 for preventative dental treatment and is renewed every 2 calendar years. This service is covered under Medicare, meaning Medicare will cover these costs and you do not have to pay for them out of pocket.

You can withdraw your consent for CDBS at anytime by contacting ADHV. For more information regarding CDBS, please visit www.humanservices.gov.au/childdental.

ADHV will check eligibility before treatment. If you give consent, upon an initial examination (88011) the Medicare Benefits amounts for each service we may further provide are listed if they are required.

Pricing is set by the Department of Health and is deducted from your Medicare balance. This is paid by Medicare. You do not need to pay these amounts.

Privacy and Consent Policy

Australian Dental Health respects your privacy. The purpose of this form is to provide you with information to assist you in choosing to consent to Australian Dental Health - (ABN: 63 618 859 591) providing dental services to your child (the Student) at their School premises; and Australian Dental Health sharing important and relevant information about the Student with the School.

In this form, the term 'Services' means dental services to be paid for by CDBS Medicare or by Australian Dental Health.

Please read each part of this form carefully. If you do not understand a part of this form, please speak with Australian Dental Health. Your child cannot receive the Services if the consent part of this form is not signed (located on page 2).

This form uses the phrase 'your child' however you may have received this form if you are able to consent to receiving the Services (because you have been classified as a mature minor or are an adult student), or if you are a guardian or informal carer of the student. Further information about who can sign this consent form can be found under the Frequently Asked Questions section of this form and at adhv.com.au/privacy.

Privacy Protection

Australian Dental Health and Schools value the privacy of every individual and are committed to protecting all personal and health information collected, disclosed and managed.

In Victoria, the laws that outline privacy requirements are the Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014 (Vic) and the Health Records Act 2001 (Vic). These laws set out what schools must do when they collect, use, handle and destroy personal and health information.

Personal information is stored and handled in Australia. It may be shared with contracted service providers for administrative and data processing purposes. Offshore contractors may assist remotely under strict confidentiality and security controls.

The Health Records Act is most relevant to the Services and provides that: Personal information is 'information or an opinion (including information or an opinion which is on a database), whether true or not, and whether recorded in a material form or not, about an individual whose identity is apparent, or can reasonably be ascertained from the information or opinion'.

Health information is information or an opinion about:

- the physical, mental or psychological health of an individual;
- a disability of an individual;
- an individual's expressed wishes about the future provision of health services to him or her;
- or a health service provided, or to be provided, to an individual, that is also personal information.

Collecting personal and health information

To enable Australian Dental Health to provide the dental services at school, it will be collecting the personal and health information of the student. Accordingly Australian Dental Health may collect and use personal and health information about the Student, such as:

- name, address, contact details;
- date of birth; Medicare number;
- physical and/or psychological health and medical information, including details about any disability the Student may have;
- other material required to conduct appropriate tests;
- express wishes about the future provision of health services, from the Student or you;
- health services that have been provided, or are to be provided;
- health information about you or the Student which is or could be predictive of health of you or the Student;
- or if you provide test results;
- and any other information about the Student which may be relevant to Australian Dental Health's provision of the Services.

Australian Dental Health respects your privacy and will only collect personal

and health information when it is necessary to provide Service to you or your child.

There may be occasions where Australian Dental Health may collect information about you or your child from other organisations such as other health professionals. For example, you may provide us with information from your local dentist to assist in our treatments. Australian Dental Health will seek your consent before doing so when it initiates the collection, however, in some instances Australian Dental Health may be directly provided with this information.

Using personal and health information

The Department of Education and Training (Department) requires Australian Dental Health providing Services to the Student to share important and relevant information about the Student with the School Principal and other school staff.

Accordingly, Australian Dental Health may discuss personal or health information in relation to you or the student with the School Principal and employees, contractors or agents of the school council or the Department, so as to:

- provide the Services to you or the student; and
- enable the teaching staff and other employees, contractors or members of the Department of education and training or the school council to discharge their duty of care to you or the Student and optimally educate and support the Student.

The types of information about the Student that may be disclosed to the School Principal include (without limitation):

- information about the Student's disability or medical condition and their needs, in the way(s) and at the times specified by the School Principal;
- information that may be relevant to the School's ability to meet its duty of care obligations to the Student;
- information that relates to reasonably foreseeable risk to anyone.

This information may be used by staff at the School for the purposes of providing educational programs to, and making adjustments for, you or the Student. The types of people who may be involved in discussions are Australian Dental Health, teachers, education support staff, other health professionals, or staff of an education and care service conducted by the school council and attended by the Student.

If personal or health information is disclosed to other Department employees, contractors or agents, or school council employees, or contractors, these people are required to comply with the Health Records Act and the Privacy and Data Protection Act (or the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) where relevant). Disclosure or use will otherwise only occur if permitted by law. In some instances, the Australian Dental Health, School Principal or the Department of Education and Training may be compelled by other laws to disclose information held about you or the Student to other bodies such as regulatory bodies, court or tribunal.

Australian Dental Health and the School will endeavour to ensure that all information held about you or the student is up to date and accurate. However, if your circumstances change, you move home, change telephone numbers or other information you have provided to Australian Dental Health becomes out of date, please inform Australian Dental Health and the School.

ADHV may contact you directly for important information, future treatments and visits.

Accessing personal and health information.

You can access and correct personal and health information held by the School or withdraw your consent to the use of this information by emailing the school or the Department of Education and Training at privacy.enquiries@edumail.vic.gov.au in accordance with the Department's Information Privacy Policy located at: <https://www.education.vic.gov.au/Pages/privacypolicy.aspx> or in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 1982 (Vic).
